Life to Eagle Checklist

This sheet is for your use to insure all requirements are met for the rank of Eagle Scout.

_____ All information **legible, neat, and complete addresses where necessary**

_____ Read “**AGE REQUIREMENT ELIGIBILITY**” on Eagle Scout Application

_____ **REQUIREMENT 1.** Be active in your troop, team, crew, or ship for a period of at least six months after you have achieved the rank of Life Scout.

_____ **REQUIREMENT 2.** Demonstrate that you live by the principles of the Scout Oath and Law in your daily life. List the names of individuals who know you personally and would be willing to provide a recommendation on your behalf.

_____ **REQUIREMENT 3.** Earn a total of 21 merit badges (required badges are listed). List the month, day, and year the merit badge was earned.

_____ **REQUIREMENT 4.** While a Life Scout, serve actively for a period of six months in one or more of the following positions of responsibility. **List only those positions served after Life board of review date.**

Boy Scout troop. Patrol leader, assistant senior patrol leader, senior patrol leader, troop guide, Order of the Arrow troop representative, den chief, scribe, librarian, quartermaster, junior assistant Scoutmaster, chaplain aide, instructor, historian, Venture patrol leader **Varsity Scout team.** Captain, cocaptain, program manager, squad leader, team secretary, librarian, quartermaster, chaplain aide, instructor, den chief, Order of the Arrow team representative **Venturing crew/ship.** President, vice president, secretary, treasurer, boatswain, boatswain's mate, yeoman, purser, storekeeper

_____ **REQUIREMENT 5.** While a Life Scout, **plan, develop, and give leadership to others** in a service project helpful to any religious institution, any school, or your community. The project idea must be approved by your Scoutmaster and troop committee and by the council or district before you start. **You must use the Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook, No. 18-927 or the official “word version” in meeting this requirement.** You must include the project name and the total number of manhours worked on your project on the Eagle Application.

_____ **REQUIREMENT 6.** Attach to this application a statement of your ambitions and life purpose and a listing of positions held in your religious institution, school, camp, community, or other organizations during which you demonstrated leadership skills. Include honors and awards received during this service. Take part in a Scoutmaster conference with your unit leader.

_____ Submit your Eagle Scout application, along with your project final write up to the Heart of Ohio Council Service Center after all appropriate signatures have been acquired. Your Eagle Board of Review will be set up once all information has been certified by the Scout Service Center.
